Batting Cage Rules

- Hitting is free, maximum of two tokens per hitter at a time. Extra tokens available after your two tokens are used. If others are waiting to use the cage they hit while you get your next tokens.
- Batter must wear shirt, shoes and helmet while in cage at all times.
- Only one person in cage at a time.
- No gum, seeds, food or drink inside cages.
- Never stand on home plate.
- Anyone under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- The Troy Sportsplex management reserves the right to refuse service to anyone at any time and ask anyone to leave if they are not acting in accordance to general rules of safety and conduct.
- No alcohol or profanity.
- Batting cage will not operate with wet balls.
- Batting cage operates off of tokens only.
- PLEASE RETURN UNUSED TOKENS TO ATTENDANT!
