Rules and Policies for Rentals

Any rental at Troy Parks and Recreation Center or Facilities

- Every City of Troy Parks and Recreation facility is provided for the enjoyment of all youth, adults and seniors of all ages. Inappropriate behavior, language and actions will not be tolerated. The event may be cancelled immediately without refund if any of these inappropriate actions are reported or observed.
- Absolutely no alcoholic beverages are allowed on City of Troy property, including facilities listed above
- Troy Parks and Recreation is not responsible for any personal belongings lost or stolen.
- The renter is expected to adhere to any instructions as directed by an employee of the City of Troy.
- You may decorate but tape, pins or nails are NOT allowed on the walls or tables.
- NO wet clothes in the hallways, after pool parties you must change into dry clothes.
- Your party should be cleaned up by the end of the event time, if you go over your scheduled time frame, you will be charged an additional \$40.
- Please understand that the swimming pools and splashpad are public facilities and the general public will still be allowed to share these facilities during your party, unless you booked a Private Party.
- The time frame is 2.5 hours for pool party's. Participants will swim for 1 hour and the last hour and half will be spent in the multipurpose room.

Murphree/Washington/Academy Street Parks

- **The renter must have a copy of their paid receipt at the event at all times.** It may be possible that group or individuals may be at your rented facility or arrived during your scheduled event and attempt to have a party or event, but only the holder of the paid receipt is determined to be the rightful occupant of the reserved facility. You are advised to call 334-566-4031 if another individual/group attempts to occupy your reserved facility, the staff at TRPD will call the Troy Police Department immediately to help resolve the situation.
- The renter must fill out the official Troy Parks and Recreation Reservation Form for the facility of Murphree Park, Washington Park and Academy Street Park no later than Wednesday, 5 p.m., if that event is expected to be held on a Saturday or Sunday
- Reservation of the pavilion at Murphree Park and Washington Park **does** allow you sole access to the facility during your rented time, but the playgrounds and bathrooms are available to all public during your scheduled event.
- IN ACCORDANCE WITH CITY OF TROY ORDINANCE, SEC. 17-4 LOUD OR EXCESSIVE NOISES:

(2) It is hereby declared a nuisance and shall be unlawful to operate or play any radio, television, phonograph, musical instrument, or similar device which produces or reproduces sound, whether from a business or a residence, in such a manner as to plainly audible AT A DISTANCE OF FIFTY (50) FEET to any person in a commercial, residential, multi-family dwelling, OR PUBLIC PLACE.

(3) Violation of this section shall be a violation and punishable by a fine not to exceed five hundred (\$500)

Swim Test for any Swimming Parties – Ages 12 and under

For the safety of our members and guests, swimmers 12 years of age and younger must choose from these options.

1. Wear a lifejacket. For swimmers who opt to wear a lifejacket, lifejackets can be provided by the lifeguards and may be used in place of taking the swim test or swimming within arms reach of a parent.
2. Be within arms reach of a parent at all times
3. Pass the Troy Parks and Recreation swim test.

Troy Parks and Recreation Swim Test

1. Start in at least 5ft of water
2. Swim 15 yards without assistance, stopping, touching the wall, or touching the bottom
3. If pass, take a picture with the filled out Troy Parks and Recreation swim test completion certificate
4. Next time you would like to come swim, show the lifeguard the picture of the completion certificate and get your green wristband
