



Recreation Center and Washington Pools have reopened

Troy Parks and Recreation has reopened the Indoor and Outdoor swimming pools at the Recreation Center as well as Washington Park swimming pool, with limitations.

Please be advised that all locker and shower rooms are still closed and not available, per the Safer At Home Order of Governor Kay Ivey.

All guests must arrive at the Recreation Center and Washington Park in their swimsuits and leave in their swimsuits. Changing rooms are not available.

The Splashpad will not be open.

Also by order of the governor, each swimming pool has a limit of customers.

The outdoor swimming pool has a limit of 25 customers, in the water and on the pool deck combined.

The Indoor Pool has a limit of 20 customers, in the water and on the pool deck. Social distancing must be observed by all customers at all times.

Customers will enter the Recreation Center at the main doors, pay, and be given a wristband that they must wear at all times, and when it is time to leave, all customers must leave through the metal gate of the outside swimming pool.

Hours of the pools at the Recreation Center for Lap Swim are 9-4, and Hours for Public Swim are 10-2, Monday through Saturday, and 2-5 on Sunday.

Washington Park Pool is open from 10-2, Monday through Friday.
