



The Recreation Center of Troy Parks and Recreation has resumed regular daily hours as of Monday, May 11 at 5 a.m., and will observe guidelines and requirements set forth by Gov. Kay Ivey's announcement of Friday, May 8, 2020.

In this limited, phased re-opening, customers will be able to utilize the Fitness Center, the indoor Walking Track, all playgrounds and both pools for lap swim and public swim, while all other aspects of the facility will not reopen immediately, but are expected to open soon.

As required in her announcement, please be aware of the following:

- Customers are expected to maintain a six-foot distance from other customers.
- Every-other treadmill and arc trainer (elliptical) will be turned off allowing six feet between working machines.
- Child Watch will be closed and not available at the Rec Center.
- All basketball, racquetball and some exercise programs are not open, but are expected to open in the near future.
- Lap Swim and public swim is available, but customers must arrive in their swimsuits and leave in their swimsuits as locker and shower rooms are closed and changing is not allowed in restrooms.
- All locker and shower rooms will be locked and unavailable.
- All customers are encouraged to wear masks and practice social distancing.
- All customers will be asked to use the provided hand sanitizer upon entering and leaving the Recreation Center.
- Customers are encouraged to bring their own water bottles as all water fountains are turned off.
- TPRD staff will be conducting regular cleaning and sanitizing of all equipment.
- All playgrounds have reopened.
