## THE DURRELL "DUKE" SMITH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

# Presented by Alabama Recreation and Parks Association District VI and the Duke Smith Family

The Alabama Recreation and Parks Association District VI affiliates annually present a scholarship in honor of Durrell "Duke" Smith.

Mr. Smith was a long-time employee of Andalusia Leisure Services in Andalusia, AL., and was involved in many aspects of the advancement of the parks and recreation profession throughout the state and nation.

One winner will be selected from District VI, which is composed of high schools with graduating seniors that have park and recreation agencies in the counties of Barbour, Butler, Coffee, Covington, Crenshaw, Dale, Geneva, Henry, Houston and Pike. The winner will receive a plaque and a cash award of \$500. The Durrell "Duke" Smith Award recognizes students based on academic achievement, sports involvement, civic involvement and community service.

#### CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

#### **ALL APPLICANTS:**

- 1. Must be a resident and high school senior in the county of either Barbour, Butler, Coffee, Covington, Crenshaw, Dale, Geneva, Henry, Houston or Pike.
- 2. Must have scored a minimum of 18 on the ACT, or SAT equivalent, and attained a 3.0 GPA (as of submission date) during the year of application.
- 3. Must have participated in at least one of the parks and recreation sports or activities while living as a resident in one of the aforementioned counties.
- Must be planning to attend a university, college or junior college for post-secondary education.
- 5. Must agree to cooperate with ARPA District VI representatives throughout the awards process.
- 6. Applications must be received by March 1 of the calendar school year.

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#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING

Completed application, with at least three recommendation letters, a copy of your high school transcript, and a photo should be turned in by March 1 of the calendar school year. If any item is missing from the packet, the packet will have to be disqualified from review.

Information desired on the Honors/Activities/Community Service pages:

- A. Education: Include all information of note regarding your high school education.
- B. Honors: Include all honors associated with your JUNIOR and SENIOR YEARS in high school, from academics to athletics to extra-curricular activities.
- C. School Extra-curricular Activities: List everything you are involved in outside of class that you are involved in from athletics, band, cheer, organizations, activities, accomplishments and leadership positions held or elected.
- D. Community Activities: List everything you are involved in outside of school from church to volunteerism, accomplishments, baby-sitting, part-time jobs, anything and everything.

It does not matter how many pages your application is. The more detailed information, the better.
